This funding will be used to

- Improve student literacy learning outcomes in writing, letter, sound and word recognition through the use of comprehensive literacy instruction.
- Improve student literacy outcomes through the analysis of data to inform differentiated instruction of letters, sounds and words and writing and the use of appropriate high impact teaching strategies.
- Increase student access to learning and improve range of communicative functions through the use of Augmentative, Alternative Communication (AAC).
- Support student access to learning by maintaining a safe, supportive, respectful learning environment.
- Improve staff wellbeing through implementation and monitoring of Wellbeing Action Plan.

Our initiatives include

- Implementing consistent, school-wide pedagogical approaches using evidence-based HITS identified in the SSS Instructional Playbooks.
- Supporting teacher analysis of student diagnostic literacy assessments to inform implementation of high impact teaching strategies for letters, sounds and words and writing.
- Improving teacher's data literacy through collegial discussions with knowledgeable others at the data wall.
- Co-construction of a school data wall to track, analyse and inform the teachers of their next steps in the teaching of writing for their individual students.
- Improving student access to learning by modelling and using a range of robust AAC systems and range of communicative functions.
- Supporting teacher analysis of student communication data through explicit and individualised feedback and the co-construction of student communication goals.
- Supporting systematic implementation of Positive Behaviour for Learning across the school campus.
- Prioritisation of wellbeing initiatives across the school campus for all employment groups.

Engaging external knowledgeable others to provide professional learning in AAC and Comprehensive Literacy Instruction to support student literacy outcomes	\$18,000
Teacher release for literacy data analysis conversations to inform use of HITS	\$10,000
Improving data literacy of all school leaders: Clarity online learning suite	\$12,515
Provision and allocation of resources to support AAC	\$12,000
Staff training in MAPA and release for behaviour support planning	\$10,000
Health, Safety and Wellbeing consultancy to support a safe and respectful learning environment for staff and students	\$50,000
